

- 1. Do a double-sided copy of flipbook "cover" and "inside".

  Note: The scissors icon may be used to determine the

  TOP of the cover page.
- 2. Fold the flipbook once vertically and once horizontally. Then unfold.
- Locate the scissors icon and make a thin DOUBLE cut on either side of the fold, to the center. Snip.
- 4. Fold flaps down and close booklet.
